Titus 2:9 Urge bondslaves to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be well-pleasing, not ^[e]argumentative,

Titus 2:10 not pilfering, but showing all good faith so that they will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect.

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, ^[f]bringing salvation to all men,

Titus 2:12 ^[g]instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age,

Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of ^[h]our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus,

Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Titus 2:15 These things speak and exhort and reprove with all ^[i]authority. Let no one disregard you

John 20:30 Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;

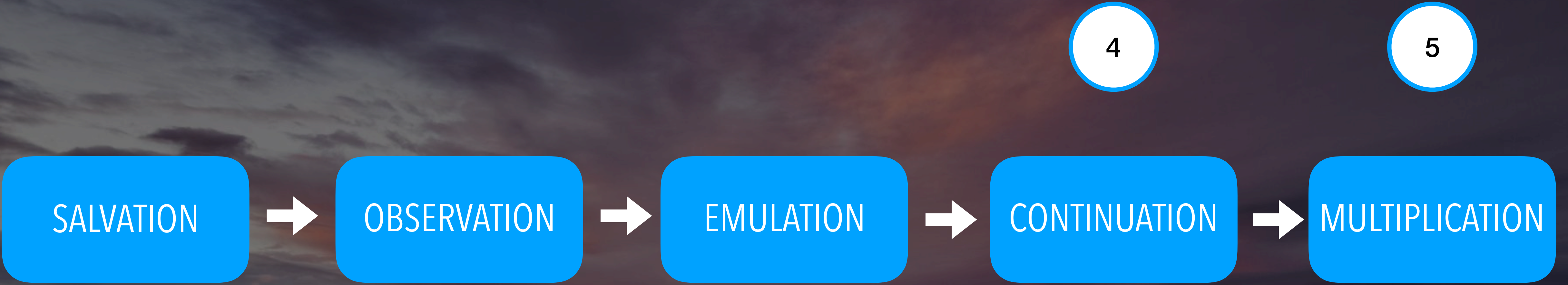
